DAPP Vocational Training School is registered with the Namibia Training Authority (NTA), and is accredited by the Namibia Qualifications Authority (NQA).

DAPP Vocational Training School, based at Onambelela near Outapi in the Omusati Region, invites suitable applicants for admission to the following trade:

 National Vocational Certificate in Horticulture and Crop Husbandry (Agriculture level 2)

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Grade 11 (revised Curricular) or Grade 12 (Phased out Curricular) with minimum 20 points in 6 subjects with an F symbol in English, Mathematics and Science.
- Grade 10 Certificate (Phased –out Curricular), with 23 points in 6 subjects.
- E symbol in English, Mathematics and Agriculture/Science.

This qualification leads to the National Vocational Certificate in Crop and Horticulture Production (Level 2 & 3) after two years of training.

WHO SHOULD APPLY?

- Unemployed Namibians
- People from socio economic disadvantaged backgrounds
- People living with disabilities, and those from marginalised communities are encouraged to apply and will be given first preference provided they meet all other admission requirements.

Which documents must accompany my application?

- · A Certified Copy of ID/Passport or other form of identification
- A Certified Copy of Educational Qualifications
- A Certified police declaration of unemployment and region of residence
 A letter from the applicant motivating why you should be considered
- A letter from a community leader motivating your need of a scholarship
